Extension activities are carried out by the students of Department of Mathematics, A.C.College for their holistic development, during the year 2020-21

The session 2020-21 started with the Covid-19 pandemic situations. The Government of India announced a Nationwide Complete lock down from 24th March 2020 and it was continued for near about two months and then partial lock down was continued. The imposition of lockdown to prevent a rise in Covid-19 infections has had a substantial impact on the country's economy, health. As such, restriction of physical activities and social isolation due to the lockdown is more of a factor in the mental and physical health of children during this crisis specially for orphans. In this crisis period Students of 5th Semester from Department of Mathematics visited Korok Children Home in Racecourse Para, Jalpaiguri on 25th January, 2021. They spent some time with the children of the home following Covid-19 protocol and tried to encourage and enlighten them and distributed pencil, paper and some dry foods among the children.
