**WORKSHOP REPORT**

The Department of Philosophy, in collaboration with the Central Library of Ananda Chandra College, hosted a one-day workshop on "*Artificial Intelligence and Ethics: A Philosophical Perspective*" on November 21, 2024. The event brought together academic minds, students, and professionals to explore the multifaceted relationship between artificial intelligence (AI) and ethics, aiming to spark critical thinking and dialogue among undergraduate students.

### **Opening Session**

The workshop commenced with an introductory speech by **Mrs. Shyamashree Adhikary**, Associate Professor and Head of the Department of Philosophy. She provided an overview of the workshop's objectives, emphasizing the need to address ethical dilemmas in AI through philosophical inquiry. She highlighted how integrating AI and ethics into the curriculum prepares students for the challenges of the modern technological landscape.



### **Inaugural Section**

**Dr. Debasish Das**, Principal of Ananda Chandra College, delivered the welcome address. Dr. Das articulated the growing importance of AI in the current era and established a link between AI and its applications in the field of chemistry. He underscored the dual nature of AI, exploring both its potential benefits and inherent risks, while encouraging students to critically evaluate its impact on society and individual lives.




### Welcome address by Dr. Debasish Das, Principal

#### Key Sessions and Insights

The first session was led by **Dr. Subhas Barman**, Head and Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science and Engineering, Jalpaiguri Government Engineering College. Dr. Barman began with a historical overview of AI, tracing its evolution from its conceptual foundations to its current advancements. He elaborated on AI's applications in everyday life, ranging from healthcare and education to industrial automation.

Dr. Barman highlighted specific case studies illustrating the transformative impact of AI on industries, while also addressing ethical challenges such as privacy, bias, and job

displacement. He emphasized the need for responsible AI development and its alignment with human values. His detailed exploration of the negative consequences of AI, including ethical and moral dilemmas, added depth to his presentation.

The second resource person, **Dr. Shamim Aktar Munshi**, Librarian of Ananda Chandra College, brought a unique perspective by focusing on ethical frameworks in the age of AI. Dr. Munshi demonstrated several practical AI tools that could enhance productivity and improve daily life. He connected his insights with five key areas of philosophy, particularly ethics, and provided an in-depth analysis of ethical issues such as accountability, transparency, and fairness in AI systems.

Dr. Munshi emphasized the importance of policy interventions, urging governments to draft comprehensive AI policies and regulations to prevent misuse. He concluded with a powerful message: while AI is a valuable tool, humans must use it as a guide and not become overly dependent on it.
